Teresa was thrilled when James Cotton came to one of her shows and got up and jammed with her. Later he was quoted as saying "I had to see her play harp for myself!" She was also invited up to jam by Delbert McClinton at his concert in Shreveport Louisiana.

Bruce Iglauer of Alligator records wrote "Teresa Lynne is quite a good harp player by any standards with voice full of good pitches and attitude and a good variety of phrasing."

In her early years she did studio (ghost) work for Charlie McCoy, Pete Drake, Bob Moore. She opened for Alice Cooper at his concert in Orlando Florida at the age of 17.
